

UWS3: What is needed to achieve sustainable sanitation management?

The workshop addressed all the necessary aspects to consider for sustainable sanitation management: including sanitation in urban planning; sanitation policies; legal and institutional frameworks; financing and subsidy mechanisms; technology selection, combination and improvement planning; O&M and human resource development; public hygiene and sanitation awareness.

The workshop was divided in two sessions with two panel discussions and a total of eight presentations. The information exchange and debates that occurred during the workshop underlined that appropriate sanitation planning requires proper financing, suitable technology selection and public awareness in sanitation. A national policy for sanitation financing is particularly needed to achieve sustainable sanitation management.
